

Costa Dining

Costa offers all kinds of dining options, so you can eat formally or casually, in the open air, in a restaurant or in your stateroom – any time of day or night! Dining choices abound from poolside dining to midnight buffets. Each day you may choose to dine Casual at the buffet, Traditional in the main restaurant or in one of our world-class Specialty restaurants (additional charge applies). Cozy bistros serve pizza, gelato, cappuccino and espresso and room service awaits your call 24 hours a day. There’s a variety of dining experiences onboard every Costa ship: “Trattoria Italiana” ~ Casual Dining in the buffet or by the pool deck. “Tradizionale” ~ Traditional Dining in the main restaurant. “Salute e Benessere” ~ Spa Menu for the health conscious. “Dining di Lusso” ~ Deluxe Dining in one of our specialty restaurants. “Piccolo Morso” ~ A Lite Bite from the buffet or room service 24 hours a day. “Pizzeria” ~ Pizza in the bistro. “Spuntino” ~ Treats to Sweets from the midnight buffet.

Dining Schedule -It is a good idea to state your preferred dining times to your travel agent at the time of booking. While Costa cannot guarantee your time of seating, we will do our best to accommodate you. Please let us know if you wish to be seated with friends. Times may vary by itinerary and vessel and may include open seating on certain days for breakfast and lunch. Most ships have specialty dining restaurants available by reservation only for dinner 7 nights a week. A nominal service charge applies.

Dress Code – Caribbean: Daytime dress on a Costa cruise is casual such as light, cotton clothing or swimwear with cover up when indoors. Most every night is informal, feel free to dress comfortably in resort attire, jackets are not required. There will be two formal evenings where you may choose to either dress formally, elegantly in a suit for men and cocktail dress for the ladies, or more casually in elegant resort wear, as how you want to enjoy your night is up to you. One of our informal nights is a Roman Bacchanal to which you may wish to wear a custom toga or accessorize your bed sheet/toga provided onboard. For guests who are interested in dressing up more formally, you may also rent a tuxedo or dinner jacket by calling Cruise Line Formal Wear Inc prior to the cruise at 1 877 88 COSTA. Your formal wear will be delivered to your stateroom before you sail and picked up at the end of your cruise. **Europe:** Daytime dress on a Costa cruise is casual such as light, cotton clothing or swimwear with cover up when indoors. Sweaters, lightweight jackets, raincoats and hats are also appropriate for Northern Europe. Tennis shoes or low-heeled walking shoes are recommended for exploring the ports of call. While most shore excursions do not have dress codes, some tours specifically prohibit shorts and sleeveless shirts, and require ladies to wear knee-length skirts or slacks. Most every night is informal, feel free to dress comfortably in resort attire, jackets are not required. There is typically one to two formal nights depending on the length of your cruise where you may choose to dress formally, elegantly in a suit for men and cocktail dress for the ladies, or more casually in elegant resort wear, as how you want to enjoy your night is up to you. **Children’s Menu** is available at the various restaurants onboard. **Special Diet Needs** - Costa will make every attempt to satisfy special dietary needs.
