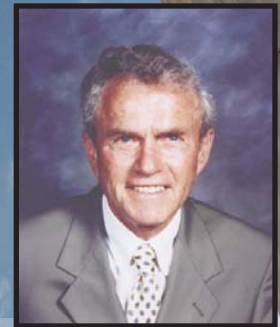
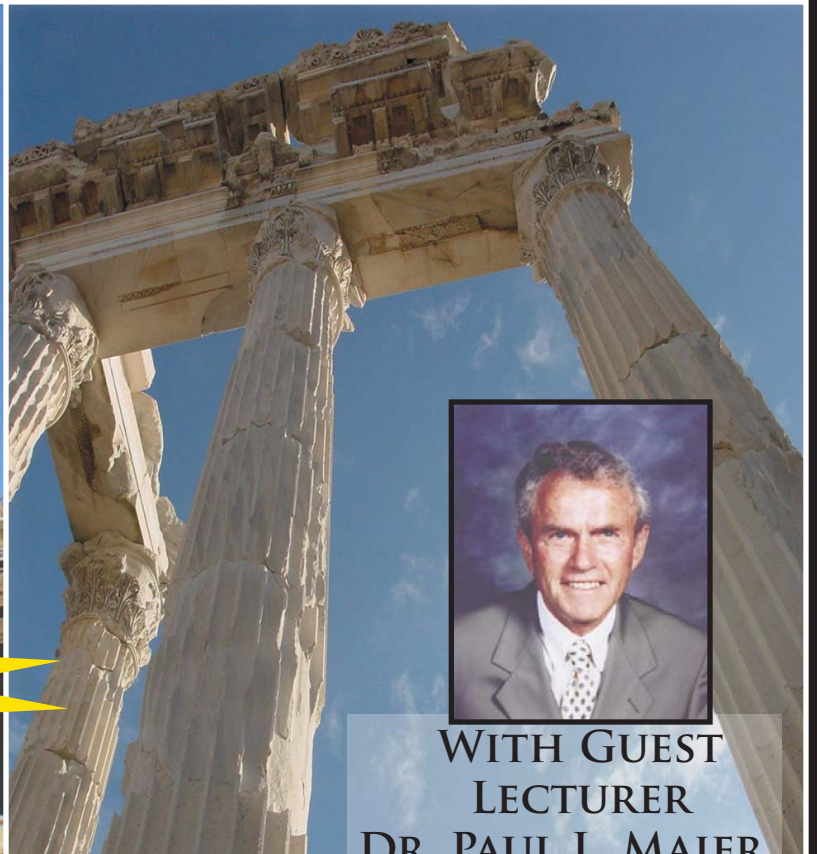

May 14-15 USA Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA and Arrive in Rome for overnight.

May 16 Ancient Rome History is woven through the streets and neighborhoods of **Rome** as in no other city. Today you'll explore the many wonders of ancient Rome when you visit the magnificent **Colosseum**. From the most sacred hill of ancient Rome, **Campidoglio**, you'll view the **Forum**. You'll also view the **Circus Maximus**, **Mamertine Prison**, the **Arch of Titus**, the famous **Baths of Caracalla** and the **Arch of Constantine**. You'll see the **Victor Emanuel Monument** and the **Monti Region**, Rome's most ancient neighborhood which spreads over three of her seven hills. Board the beautiful Royal Caribbean Mariner of the Seas. (Lunch on Own.)



May 17 & 18 At Sea

May 19 Alexandria, Egypt Dock in **Alexandria**, founded in 331 B.C. by Alexander the Great. See the site of the **Ancient Library**, **lighthouse**, and **Pompey's Pillar** during your tour of Alexandria. Visit the **catcombs** and enjoy time to explore the **old city**.

May 20 Cairo, Egypt

Travel to **Cairo**, Egypt's capitol city meaning "The Triumphant". Cairo is the most populated metropolitan area in Africa. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza**, the **Egypt Museum**, and the **King Tut Treasures**.

May 21 Galilee, Israel

Travel inland to the **Sea of Galilee**. You'll stand on the **Mount of the Beatitudes** where Jesus gave his most well-known sermon (Luke 6:12-49). At **Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10-17). Visit the **Chapel of the Primacy** where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). Travel to the shore town of **Capernaum** where Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, John (Matt 4:13) and later Matthew. Stop by the **River Jordan** where those who wish to be baptized may do so. (Lunch will be on your own today.)



May 22 Bethlehem & Jerusalem, Israel

Travel to **Bethlehem** where you'll visit the cave revered as the place where Jesus was born (Matt. 1: 18 - 25; Luke 2: 1- 7). The church, which was constructed on the site, is the world's oldest functioning church. Go to **Jerusalem** and visit the **Upper Room**, the traditional site of the Last Supper. Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas**, where Jesus was tried before the Sanhedrin. Stand upon the **Mount of Olives** and view the city as Jesus did. Wander among the olive trees of the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Enter the **Old City** and visit the **Pool of Bethesda**. You'll walk along the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**.



May 23 At Sea

May 24 Ephesus, Turkey Journey to **Ephesus**, the marble city where Paul spent three years of his ministry. The ruins of Ephesus have been restored much like the city was in Paul's time. You will visit the ancient **Agora** and view the **Great Theater**. (Lunch Included.)



May 25 Corinth and Athens Travel to **Corinth** (Acts 18: 1-18), a city that inspired St. Paul's most familiar letter. You will visit the **Archaeological Museum**, the **Market Place**, and **Temples**. Walk among the ruins and stand on the **Bema** where Paul stood. Read Paul's letter to the Corinthians and visualize his address to the Gentiles as he began the task of building Corinth's church. The architectural splendors of the ancient city of **Athens** are as magical as ever. View the world-renowned **Acropolis**, the **Propylaea**, and the **Parthenon**. Time permitting view **Mars Hill** where Paul debated with the intellectual community of his day. Walk among the ruins of the **Agora**, the ancient market place and center of Athenian public life. You will view the **Olympic Stadium**, home of the Olympics. (Lunch on Own.)



May 26 At Sea

May 27 Naples and Pompeii In the early morning, your ship will dock in **Naples**, a dazzling city perched on a beautiful rock coast. **OPTIONAL TOUR:** Journey inland to ancient **Pompeii**, dating almost to the time of Paul, where you will visit the spectacular ruins that were covered by the eruption of **Mt. Vesuvius** in 79 A.D. Paul also landed in the Bay of Naples on his way to Rome! (Lunch on Ship.)

Guest Speaker: *Dr. Paul L. Maier*

Dr. Maier is The Russell H. Seibert Professor of Ancient History at Western Michigan University and a much-published author of both scholarly and popular works. His novels include two historical documentaries: *Pontius Pilate* and *The Flames of Rome*, as well as a theological thriller that became #1 national bestseller in religious fiction: *A Skeleton in God's Closet*. A sequel, *More Than a Skeleton*, appeared in 2003.

His non-fiction works include *In the Fullness of Time*, a book that correlates secular evidence from the ancient world impinging on Jesus and early Christianity; *Josephus - The Essential Works*, a new translation/commentary on writings of the first-century Jewish historian; and *Eusebius -- The Church History*, a similar book on the first Christian historian.

More than seven million Maier books are now in print in seventeen languages, as well as over 250 scholarly articles and reviews in professional journals.

Dr. Maier lectures widely, appears frequently in national radio, television, and newspaper interviews, and has received numerous awards. He has also penned seven children's books, and produced three four-hour video series dealing with Jesus, St. Paul, and the early church.
