Jesus in the Galilee 2011

Day 1 and 2 USA to the Holy Land Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel. Travel to the countryside of **the Galilee**. Enjoy dinner before you rest overnight in your Galilee hotel.

Day 3 Mt. Arbel, Nazareth, Mount of Precipice, Nazareth Village, Sepphoris Travel to **Mount Arbel** and walk along its peak for a stunning view of the **Sea of Galilee** and the area in which Jesus ministered, with extended views of Mt. Hermon in the north and Mt. Tabor in the south. It is a magnificent photo opportunity. Visit **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of Jesus (Matthew 2: 23) and the **Mount of Precipice** where Luke describes how Jesus was rejected by those in the synagogue after He taught them. Filled with anger they "led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong" (Luke 4: 29). Explore the **Nazareth Village**, a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. Visit **Sepphoris**, the cosmopolitan Roman capital of Galilee until Herod Antipas built Tiberias. It is heralded as the traditional birthplace of Mary.

Day 4 Hazor, Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Mt. Hermon and the Golan Heights Explore **Hazor**, one of the oldest archaeological sites in Israel. The 3000 year old city was the inspiration for The Source, James Michener's epic history of the region. Here, Joshua fought against Jabin (Josh. 11: 1-11). Hazor was later fortified by Solomon. At nearby **Tel Dan**, see the mud brick arch constructed in pre-Israelite (Canaanites) times and where The House of David fragment-from the First Temple Period-was discovered. Visit **Caesarea Philippi**, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where nearby Peter made his great confession to Jesus, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16: 16). Continue on to **Mount Hermon**, probably the site of the Lord's Transfiguration (Matt. 17: 1-9). Travel on through the strategic tableland known as the **Golan Heights**.

Day 5 Nof Ginnosar, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Kursi, Bethsaida, Chorazim Watch the sunrise over the **Sea of Galilee** where fishermen work the waters with nets much as in the time of Jesus. Ride across the waters to explore **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4:13, 23). Visit the peaceful **Mount of Beatitudes** which overlooks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. Not far away is **Bethsaida** where Jesus chose five of his disciples (Matt. 4: 18-21; John 1: 39-51). Visit **Chorazim**, the town cursed by Jesus because He did mighty works there and they "repented not" (Matt. 11: 21). On the far shore of the sea is **Kursi** where Jesus cast out evil spirits from a demon-possessed man and cast them into a group of swine which ran violently down a steep hill and drowned in the sea (Mark 5: 1-13). At **Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar**, you will learn about the "Ancient Boat", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed.

Day 6 Yardenit Baptismal Site, Beit Shean, Gideon's Spring, Mt. Gilboa, Megiddo At the **Yardenit Baptismal site**, situated where the **Jordan River** flows out of the Sea of Galilee on its way to the Dead Sea, enjoy the peace and tranquility of the natural surroundings and participate in a baptismal service in the river in which Christ was baptized by John the Baptist (Mark 1: 9-11). Travel to the ruins of **Beit Shean** where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls there after they were killed in battle (I Sam. 31: 10,12). Beit Shean is also noted for having the best-preserved ancient Roman theatre in Israel. Also visit **Gideon's Spring** (Ein Harod) where Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the springs (Jd. 7). The spring is in the shadow of **Mt. Gilboa** where Saul fought and died. His death made David lament and pray that no dew would fall on the mountain (2 Sam. 1:19-27). You will view the mountain and see that, to this day, Mt Gilboa is bare of trees. Travel the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo** where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other, and where Solomon built his stables.

Day 7 Leisure Day with Optional tour to Caesarea, The Emmaus Road and Ein Karem Explore on your own or visit (additional charge) **Caesarea**, where you will see the ancient Roman aqueduct and theatre. View the road of **Emmaus** where Jesus, after His resurrection, met two of his disciples who did not recognize Him until He later broke bread with them in their home. Continue to **Ein Karem**, traditionally known as the birthplace of John the Baptist, and where tradition holds that Mary journeyed to share with Elisabeth her good news (Luke 1: 39-48).

Day 8 Jerusalem, Mt. of Olives, Bethlehem, Mt. Zion, Upper Room, City of David, Garden of Gethsemane In Jerusalem, view **Hezekiah's Tunnel**, walk to the **Garden of Gethsemane** via the **Kidron Valley** and pray there as Jesus prayed (Matt. 26: 36-44). Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of **Jerusalem**. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). On **Mount Zion** view the site of **King David's Tomb**. Stand in the **Upper Room**, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12-26). In **Bethlehem**, visit the cave where Jesus was born and the church, which has been constructed on the site (Matt. 1: 18-25; Luke 2: 1-7). Nearby, view the **Shepherds' Field** where the Good News was first heard.

Day 9 Southern Wall Excavations, Teaching Steps, Western Wall, Pool of Bethesda, Via Dolorosa, Garden Tomb Visit the **Davidson Center** and the **Southern Wall Excavations** including the **Teaching Steps** and the **Western Wall**. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Visit **Herod's Antonia Fortress** where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, the "Way of the Cross", and stand in reverence at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Visit the **Garden Tomb**, the possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea, and experience the reality of the Resurrection.

Day 10 Return to the USA Enjoy one of the exciting extensions or depart and arrive in the USA.

Cairo and the Route of the Exodus

7-day* extension \$898

Day 10 Early morning departure from Jerusalem. Cross the Sinai, traveling ancient caravan routes across the **Sinai** to the base of **Mt. Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to **Elim** where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Continue to **Cairo** for dinner and a four night stay.

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**.

Day 13 Travel south to view **Joseph's River and Lake**, created by Joseph during the period of the seven years of famine. Visit a **grain silo** of the kind established under Joseph's rule to store grain during the seven years of famine. Tour the rural region of traditional Egyptian farming and stop at an **old corn water mill**.

Day 14 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**.

Day 15 Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Egypt and Luxor

7-day* extension \$1298

Day 10 - 11 Your itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. In the early evening, board the overnight train to Luxor.

Day 13 & 14 (Lunches included on these days.) Cross the Nile River to visit the **Valley of Kings and Queens**. After overnight in Luxor, visit the magnificent **Karnak Temple** and the **Luxor Temple**. **Fly to Cairo**.

Day 15 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**. Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Jerusalem Extended Stay

Day 10 -11 Your itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 This morning you will enjoy a half day tour of **Cairo**, including the **Egyptian Museum**, the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. This afternoon you will fly to Aswan where you will board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 Visit the **High Dam of Aswan** and the **Granite Quarry** where you can see the **Unfinished Obelisk**. Visit the **Temple of Philae** before sailing to the beautiful **Temple of Kom Ombo**. After your visit to the temple shared by two gods, your cruise continues along the **Nile**.

Day 14 Visit the **Temple of Horus** in **Edfu**. Continue via the **Nile Lock** and sail to **Luxor**.

Day 15 Disembark and cross to the Western Bank where you will visit the **Necropolis of Thebes**, the **Valley of the Kings and Queens**, the **Temple of Hatshepsut** and the **Colossi of Memnon**. On the East Bank, you'll visit the amazing **Temples of Luxor and Karnak**. Fly back to **Cairo** for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

***Note: The Cairo Route of the Exodus Extension and the Egypt Luxor Extension will operate together on Days 10-12**

Wonders of Jordan and Petra

Day 10 In the morning, you will cross the Allenby Bridge into Jordan. View the "promised land" as Moses did from the summit of **Mt. Nebo**. Nearby **Madaba** is home to a beautiful 6th century mosaic of Jerusalem. Visit Philadelphia, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis, and now **Amman**.

Day 11 Early in the morning you'll journey to the famous rock city of **Petra**, literally cut into the cliff sides. Return to Amman for a late dinner and overnight.

Day 12 Explore the ruins of **Jerash**, Jordan's best-preserved Greco-Roman town. Depart the Holy Land this evening.

Day 13 Arrive in the USA.
