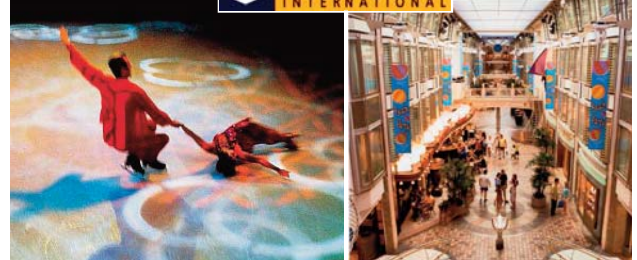
### COZUMEL, MEXICO
