

Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 181 days prior to departure, you will be charged a \$100 penaltie plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges also apply: 180-151 days prior to departure = \$200; 150-121 days prior to departure = \$300; 120-91 days prior to departure to day of departure = 50% of penalty; 90-61 days prior to departure to day of departure = 75% of penalty, 60-0 days prior to departure to day of departure = 100% of penalty. Cancellation must be submitted in writing. On or after day of departure, no refund for any services not used.
