



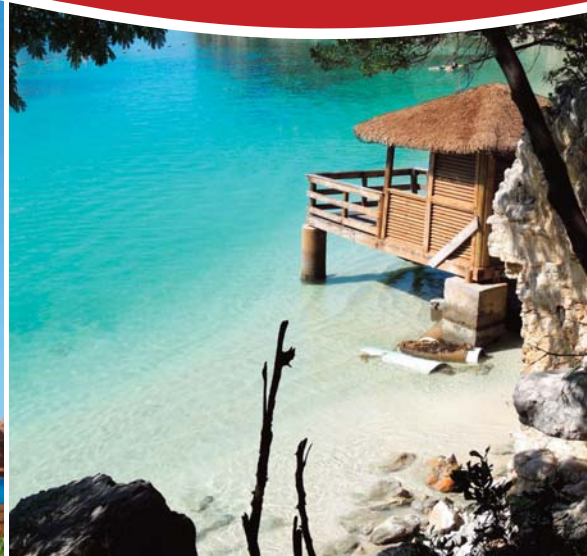

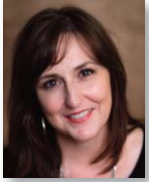

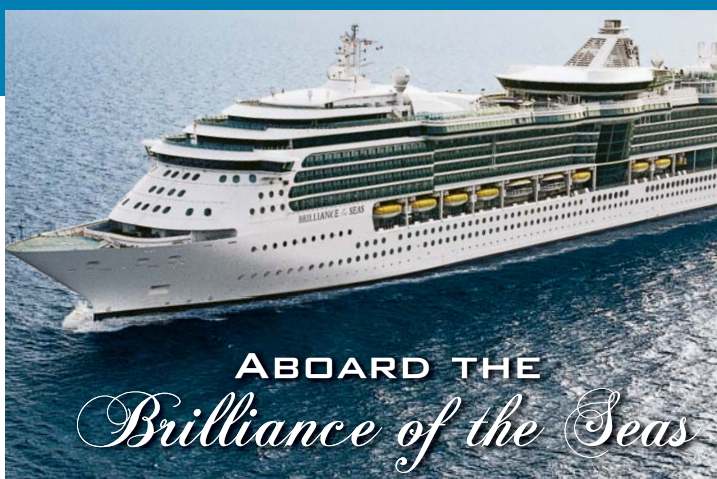

Travel Protection Premiums must be paid by the final payment date for coverage to be in effect. Final payment for trip is due 09/27/17. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100 will be assessed.

REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED AFTER September 27, 2017:

We welcome registrations after 09/27/17. Registrations received after this date may incur an additional fee based on cruise availability. Additional fees will be advised upon registration.

CANCELLATION FEES:

The optional Travel Protection Program covers 100% of Cancellation Fees, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From Day of registration to 121 days prior to departure, you will be charged a \$100 non-refundable cancellation fee.
