



Lloyd Larson

Lloyd Larson has been an active composer and arranger for several years and is a regular contributing writer to Alfred Publishing Co. music catalogs, as well as many other music publishers' catalogs. In addition, Mr. Larson owns his own publishing company, LarSong Publications. A frequently called upon clinic and conference resource person, Mr. Larson has been a singer, keyboard player and arranger.

Having earned his B.A. from Anderson University, Anderson, IN, Mr. Larson next completed his M.C.M. from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary (SBTS), Louisville, KY, and completed additional graduate work at SBTS and Ohio State University.

His extensive background in arranging and composing includes arranging music for an internationally broadcast radio program. Also, in 1989, he completed an editorial assignment for a new hymnal, entitled *Worship the Lord*, for the Church of God. Mr. Larson also co-edited the Hymnal Companion for that hymnal. In addition, Mr. Larson contributed to the recently released *The Complete Library of Christian Worship*, edited by Dr. Robert Webber.



Diane Earle

Dr. Diane Earle has performed in thirteen countries, including three extensive China tours. She is spokesperson for Yangtze River Piano Company in China, and Ambassador to the Nyali

Music School in Mombasa, Kenya. On the local/regional scene, Dr. Earle is Artist in Residence, Director of the Music Program, and Professor of Music at Kentucky Wesleyan College, where she founded and directs the "Panther Pianists" community outreach program. As Music Director at Settle Memorial United Methodist Church, she founded and directs the Good Samaritan Concert Series, which raises thousands of dollars each year to help combat area homelessness. She is principal pianist for the Owensboro Symphony Orchestra, and presents many educational programs for OSO, RiverPark Center, and regional school systems. Diane received a Bachelor of Music degree in Piano Performance, magna cum laude, from University of Cincinnati's College-Conservatory of Music. Her Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees in Piano Performance and Literature were from The Ohio State University. She did additional doctoral and post-doctoral study at Eastman School of Music, Indiana University, Music Academy of the West, Blossom Festival School, and New York City.



Mark Cabaniss

Mark Cabaniss is a music publisher, producer, and composer based in Nashville, Tennessee. As an ASCAP composer and arranger, Mark's published compositions have been performed nationally and abroad, and include musicals,

cantatas, and instrumental works. His stage adaptation of the film *It's a Wonderful Life*, titled *Miracle in Bedford Falls* (premiered by the Southern Appalachian Repertory Theatre), has been subsequently performed coast-to-coast. Other musicals include *The Homework Machine*, *The Stardust Supper Club*, and *The 50th Annual Polk County Picnic*.

Mark is a multiple recipient of ASCAP's Popular Music Award and a Dove Award and Angel Award-winning producer. He is a member of the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences (Grammy) and serves on the Board of Advisors for The Music Man Square, a museum and foundation in Mason City, Iowa, dedicated to furthering music education and honoring the legacy of Meredith Willson (creator of Broadway's *The Music Man*). Mark was named Outstanding Alumnus of the Year by Mars Hill University and serves on the University's Board of Trustees. Mark also founded and permanently endowed The Helen Cole Krause Music Scholarship.

Mark's work in music business and broadcasting has led to collaborations with television icon Andy Griffith, Academy Award-winner Shirley Jones, legendary entertainer Steve Allen, Broadway/pop songwriter Rupert Holmes, broadcaster Kathie Lee Gifford, producer/composer/conductor Buryl Red, gospel singer Cynthia Clawson, and others. Mark also serves as an adjunct professor of Music Business at Belmont University in Nashville. He holds degrees in Music Education and Communications from Mars Hill University and the University of Tennessee at Knoxville.


