# THE JOURNEYS OF PAUL



## November 7, 2015 – Depart USA

Board your international flight to Rome.

## November 8, 2015 – Arrive in Rome

Arrive in **Rome, Italy** and embark on the Royal Caribbean “Rhapsody of the Seas.”

## November 9, 2015 – At Sea

## November 10, 2015 – Chania, Crete (On Own)

Dock in **Crete** today. Paul set sail from Crete on his voyage to Rome which ended in shipwreck.

## November 11, 2015 – Athens & Corinth, Greece

The architectural splendors of the ancient city of **Athens** are as magical as ever. Follow your guide on a journey to the ancient **Acropolis** where you will see the **Propylaea**, the **Parthenon** and the **Erechtheum**. View **Mars Hill** where Paul preached the gospel to the intellectual Athenian community of his day (Acts 17: 15-34). You will view the **Olympic Stadium**, where the modern Olympics began. Travel to **Corinth** (Acts 18: 1-18), a city that inspired St. Paul's most familiar letters. You will visit the **Archaeological Museum**, the **Market Place** where Paul's workshop may have been located, the **Captives Facade** and the **Asklepion**. Among the ruins, we can stand on the **Bema** where Paul defended the gospel. From a distance, view **Acrocorinth** that looms over the city with its temples and fortifications.

## November 12, 2015 – Ephesus & Miletus, Turkey

Drive to **Miletus** where Paul met the elders of the churches in Ephesus on his trip to deliver the Jerusalem Offering. We visit the theater with famous inscriptions about seats reserved for Jewish citizens. After Lunch, visit **Ephesus** where Paul had a three year ministry and where the disciple John and Jesus' mother Mary are buried. With a population of more than 250,000, Ephesus was the second largest city in the world. View the **Library of Celsus**, originally built in 125 C.E., that once held nearly 12,000 scrolls. Visit the **temples of Hadrian and Domitian**, and the great **theater** where Paul witnessed.

## November 13, 2015 – Rhodes, Greece

Paul visited **Rhodes** briefly on his way to Jerusalem at the end of his 3rd missionary journey (Acts 21:1). You will see the castles and the old city which still impress visitors. Over 4,000 years ago, the Minoans were among the greatest civilizations in Europe.

## November 14, 2015– At Sea

## November 15, 2015– Valetta, Malta

Paul was shipwrecked on Malta around 60 A.D. (Acts 9). See St. Paul's Bay in Valetta as well as St. John's Co-Cathedral. Its lavish interior includes Carvaggio's masterpiece, “The Beheading of John the Baptist.”

## November 16, 2015– At Sea

## November 17, 2015– Cagliari, Sardinia, Italy (On Own)

**Cagliari** is one of the island's liveliest cities, and it just so happens to be your port of call. This city offers the best of everything: colorful festivals, architectural wonders, historic monuments, tranquil lagoons, and one of the longest beaches in the Mediterranean.

Dr. Waite Willis is the Edward J. Pendergrass Professor of Religion at Florida Southern College and a professor for the summer Course of Study program at the Emory Candler School of Theology. He is an ordained Elder in the United Methodist Church and serves on the Florida Conference Board of Directors for Camping and retreat Ministries.

Professor Willis is the author of the book *Theism, Atheism, and the Doctrine of the Trinity*, co-author of the book *Resurrection: The Origin and Future of a Stunning Concept* and author of a book chapter on "The Archaeology of Faith and the Archaeology of Palestine: Between a Rock and a Hard Place."

Dr. Willis holds many awards including the Distinguished Alumni Award from Candler School of Theology, Emory University and the Presidential nominee for Outstanding Educator Award given by The United Methodist Foundation for Christian Higher Education.

Waite has served as a popular guest speaker for the Memphis and Tennessee United Methodist Conferences, The Florida Center for Science and Religion as well as several churches.
