



Oct. 9 - Departure

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA.

Oct. 10 - Arrive in Athens, Greece

Arrive in Athens, Greece and embark on the Azamara Journey.

Oct. 11 - Mykonos, Greece (On Own)

Have a delightful day exploring the exceptional beauty and culture of the Greek island of Mykonos with its lovely bays and beaches, distinctive whitewashed structures, and cobblestone streets.

Shore excursions are booked through Azamara.

Oct. 12 - Heraklion, Crete

The Bible mentions Crete as the port of origin for Paul's voyage that ended in shipwreck. In Heraklion you will explore the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Partially reconstructed, the elaborate Palace was the seat of ancient Minoan culture, and is believed to be the inspiration for the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos. The Archaeological museum in Heraklion displays many of the treasures found during the excavations.

Oct. 13 - Patmos, Greece

We will set sail for the Island of Patmos. Visit the Monastery of St. John, high on the mountain overlooking the entire island. Walk down to the Grotto of the Apocalypse and the caves where the exiled Apostle John lived, and inspired by God, wrote the book of Revelation as well as other letters to the early church.

Oct. 14 - Ephesus, Turkey

Drive to Ephesus, the marble city where Paul spent three years of his ministry. The ruins of Ephesus have been restored much like the city was in Paul's time. You will visit the ancient Agora and view the Great Theater. View the terrace houses, also known as "the house of the rich," which give a true impression of the ancient lifestyle. Also, visit the Ephesus Archaeological Museum for a look at some of Ephesus' most prized artifacts.

Oct. 15 - Rhodes, Greece

Paul visited Rhodes briefly on his way to Jerusalem at the end of his third missionary journey. Over 1,200 years later when Jerusalem fell during the Crusades, the Knights of St. John fled to the island of Rhodes, where they ruled for two centuries. Suleiman the Magnificent finally captured the island, but lost 50,000 men in the campaign. The castles and old town built by the knights are still impressive today.

Oct. 16 - Santorini, Greece (On Own)

Explore Santorini, one of the most beautiful of the Greek islands. Its picturesque whitewashed villages with brilliant blue domes dot the cliffs above the Aegean Sea. The island itself perches on the edges of a volcano whose eruption 3,500 years ago is thought to have led to the collapse of the Minoan civilization.

Shore excursions are booked through Azamara.

Oct. 17 - Athens to USA

Disembark the Azamara Journey and return home.



Oct. 7 - Depart USA

Oct. 8 - Arrive in Athens.

Overnight in Athens, free time in afternoon and evening.

Oct. 9 - Corinth, Canal and Cenchreae Tour

Travel to Corinth (Acts 18:1-18) and visit the Archaeological Museum, the Market Place the Captives Façade and the Asklepiion. Among the ruins, we can stand on the Bema where Paul defended the gospel. From a distance, view Acrocorinth. Cross the Corinth canal, begun in Roman times, but not completed until the late 1800's. Stop at the site of Cenchreae, a port city whose remains are almost entirely under water. From here, the apostle Paul sailed for Jerusalem (Acts 18). Overnight in Athens.

Oct. 10 - Athens Touring

Visit the architectural splendors of the ancient Athens. Journey to the ancient Acropolis where you will see the Propylaea, the Parthenon and the Erechtheum. View Mars Hill where Paul preached the gospel (Acts 17:15-34). You will also view the Olympic Stadium. Board the Azamara Journey this afternoon.
