





**September 13 – DEPART USA**

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on your international overnight flight.

**September 14 – ARRIVE IN VENICE, ITALY**

You will arrive in Venice, Italy where you will be met by our representative and transferred the port to board the Celebrity Constellation. (D)

**September 15 – AT SEA**

**September 16 – KATAKOLON, GREECE (On Own)**

Explore Katakolon, a lovely port town on your own today or choose to step back in time 2,000 years with a visit to the ruins of Olympia and imagine the roar of the spectators as athletes took their marks on the marble starting blocks in the stadium at ancient Olympia. (B,L,D) *Shore excursions today will be booked directly through Celebrity and are not included.*

**September 17 – SANTORINI, GREECE (On Own)**

Dock in Santorini today, one of the most beautiful of the Greek islands where picturesque whitewashed villages topped with brilliant blue domes stand in stark contrast to the sheer drop cliffs overlooking the Aegean Sea. The island itself perches on the edges of a volcano whose eruption 3,500 years ago is thought to have led to the collapse of the Minoan civilization. Explore the island on your own or join one of the optional excursions available for purchase onboard. (B,L,D) *Shore excursions today will be booked directly through Celebrity and are not included.*

**September 18 - EPHEBUS, TURKEY**

Ephesus is another of the Seven Churches of Revelation and was once a bustling port town graced with wide, colonnade-bordered streets and a population of 250,000. Although spectacular excavations have revealed much of the glory of ancient Ephesus, including the huge Agora and Library, much has been lost. The ancient world once declared the Temple of Artemis to be one of the Seven Wonders of the World but today, only a single column remains to mark its site. View the terrace houses, also known as “the houses of the rich,” which give a true impression of ancient lifestyle. Explore the Museum of Ephesus for an up-close look at ancient artifacts. You will have time to explore on your own and recreate some of the footsteps of Paul. (B,L,D)

**September 19 - MYKONOS, GREECE (On Own)**

Arrive today at the world-famous Greek Island of Mykonos, where gleaming whitewashed buildings seem to climb atop each other to reach the azure sky. Admire its many hills dotted with iconic windmills. Explore the island on your own or join one of the optional excursions available for purchase onboard. (B,L,D) *Shore excursions today will be booked directly through Celebrity and are not included.*

**September 20 - ATHENS & CORINTH, GREECE**

Discover the rich architectural splendor of the ancient city of Athens as your guide introduces you to the world-renowned Acropolis, the Propylaea, the Parthenon and the Erectheum. Stand on Mars Hill as the apostle Paul did when he proclaimed, “I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you”. As you stroll the Agora (ancient market place and center of Athenian public life), recall that this

was where the Apostle Paul preached “Jesus and the resurrection” to the skeptical Athenians. Also see the House of Parliament, the Presidential Palace and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This afternoon tour the city of Corinth, where the apostle Paul met fellow tentmakers Aquila and Priscilla and received a vision from the Lord saying, “I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city”. As Paul spoke, Crispus (chief ruler of the synagogue) and many others believed and were baptized, establishing the church at Corinth to whom Paul later wrote his two epistles. Discover the Archaeological Museum, Market Place and Temples. As you walk among the ruins, stand on the Bema, where the apostle Paul stood before Gallio to face charges brought against him by the Jews. (B,L,D)

**September 21 - CHANIA, CRETE**

Delve into a Cretan cultural experience that includes guided sightseeing at Lake Kournas, the Arkadi Monastery and the bustling town of Rethymnon. First stop is at Lake Kournas, where you’ll savor a delicious treat of traditional cheese pie with honey, among white sands and ancient olive trees. Next up is a tour of the fortress-like monastery, whose history dates to Byzantine times. Finish with a stroll through distinctively ancient yet distinctly modern Rethymnon. (B,L,D)

**September 22 – CORFU, GREECE**

Admire the unbridled opulence of Achilleion Palace, built in honor of the great Greek hero Achilles. The palace was designed by legendary Italian architect, Raffaele Caritto, and its gardens feature works by renowned German sculptor, Ernst Herter. Continue your adventure along the Bay of Paleokastritsa, often called the “Capri of Greece” due to its stunning vistas. Drive into the surrounding hills to the Byzantine Monastery of the Virgin. This ancient religious hideaway is still inhabited by a community of monks who invite guests to explore their museum housing priceless icons and relics, and stroll among gardens offering up sweeping views of the bay below. Afterwards, return to Corfu Town for free time to wander about the charming alleys and browse its many shops.
