Holy Land 2019

Oct. 23 – Depart USA (W)

Depart on your international overnight flight.

Oct. 24 - Arrive Tel Aviv (H)

Arrive in Tel Aviv, where your guide will greet you at the airport and escort you to your bus for the transfer to your Netanya area hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct. 25 – Caesarea, Megiddo, Nazareth (F)

Begin your day traveling along the Mediterranean Coast to Caesarea. You'll visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new religion (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for Trial. Travel the ancient caravan route through the Jezreel Valley to Tel Megiddo where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Continue on to Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2: 23). Explore the Nazareth Village, a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. Check into your Galilee area hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct. 26 – Sea of Galilee Sites (S)

At Tabgha, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the Church of the Fish and the Loaves (Luke 9:10-17). You'll also visit the Chapel of the Primacy where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). Travel to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt. 4:13, 23). Continue on to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). Continue to Kursi, considered part of the region of the Gadarenes in Christ's time, and remember where Christ cast the demons into the swine (Mark 5). At Kibbutz Nof Ginosar, you'll learn about the "Ancient Boat", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed. Tour the kibbutz and experience what life is like in this communal setting. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct. 27 – Upper Galilee (U)

Begin today with a visit to the ancient remains of Tel Dan and the altar built by King Jeroboam I (I Kings 12:25 -30). You'll journey to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ" (Matthew 16). Walk to the Banias Spring nearby. Look out from the slopes of Mount Hermon at Nimrod's Castle. This Muslim and Crusader fortress was named for the biblical Nimrod (Genesis 8). Stop at a traditional Druze Village, perhaps have a cup of coffee with locals. With Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a Kinneret Sailing Company boat. Along the way, participate in a special onboard worship service. Return to your hotel for dinner

and overnight.

Oct. 28 – Jordan Valley (M)

This morning head south through the Jordan Valley, Past Jericho, the oldest known inhabited city in the world. Along the route, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4: 1-11) and the Judean wilderness. Travel to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Continue south to visit Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod that became the final desperate stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. From the top of Masada, the Roman camps and siege ramp can still be seen. Then journey "up" to Jerusalem, and look out over the city from the heights of Mount Scopus. Check into your Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct. 29 – Christian Jerusalem (T)

Walk to the Garden of Gethsemane and pray there as Jesus prayed (Matt. 26:36 - 44). Next door is the Church of All Nations. In the courtyard are Olive Trees whose roots date back to before the time of Christ. Inside the church is the stone where tradition holds Jesus prayed the night before His crucifixion. Pause at the Crusader Church that is thought to mark the Tomb of Mary at the base of the Mount of Olives. On Mount Zion you will stand in the Upper Room, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12 - 26). Walk through some of the ancient rooms of Caiaphas' the High Priest's house beneath the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Here Jesus was held overnight before His crucifixion (Luke 22). Visit the Davidson Center and the Southern Wall Excavations including the Teaching Steps. Pray at the Western Wall. Wander the Old City of Jerusalem, and walk the Cardo, the ancient main street of the Old City once lined with shops and now partially restored. Experience the Arab Souk market area. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Optional Sound and Light Show at the Citadel in the Old City (additional cost).

Oct. 30 – Jerusalem, Via Dolorosa (W)

Enter the Old City through St. Stephen's Gate, also known as the Lion's Gate. View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Lift your voice at the acoustically magnificent St. Anne's Church. Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross". Stop at the Crown of Thorns Chapel - Station One of the stations of the Cross. See the pavement from the Antonia Fortress in the basement of the Sisters of Zion Church. Here "games" Roman soldiers played are carved into the stone. The grooved stones indicate that horses departed from the fortress here, and it is the traditional beginning of the Via Dolorosa. At the Ecce homo Arch, Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). See an example of an 'eye of the needle' at the Alexander hospice. Stand

in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit and worship at the Garden Tomb, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea, and experience the reality of the Resurrection. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct. 31 – Emmaus/free time (H)

Travel back in time in the Rabbi's Tunnel, where foundation stones and other stone work survives from the Second Temple. Drive to the Valley of Elah, where David slew Goliath. The group will journey to Emmaus and visit the Latrun Monastery for a final communion service. This afternoon you will have two options:

Option 1 - an afternoon tour of Bethlehem, including the Church of the Nativity and Shepherds' Fields.

Option 2 - free time on your own in the Old City, where you can choose to visit Hezekiah's Tunnel, Visit the David Tower and Citadel Museum, shop in the Arab Souk Market, or just wander the Old City. Return to the hotel to prepare for your return flights home. Those taking the Jordan Extension will return for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 1 - Return to USA or Continue on Jordan Extension
