## October 23 - Boston, MA

5:00 PM Departure

Toting over 400 years of history, Boston is one of the oldest cities in America. For much of the year, sunlight touches the United States first at Cadillac Mountain on the Maine Coast. From the granite-slabbed summit, light tiptoes down across the rest of Mount Desert Isle, Acadia National Park, the town of Bar Harbor and then the rest of the country. The raw coastal scenery attracted Hudson River School painters in the 1840s, and their art in turn lured visitors to the area - a lot of them. Before you know it, Bar Harbor was a haven for the East Coast glittering class and was bejeweled with grand mansions and immaculate gardens. Cruise visitors can walk the streets of town, relax on the Village Green, or climb Cadillac Mountain. You'll see that the grandeur abides.

#### **Living the Anxiety Algorithm: The Biblical Response to Worry and Crisis**

In seems our world is consumed by anxiety and worry. In fact, the crisis of pandemic and social unsettled ness, has redefined much of what we know our world. In this study cruise, two experts on dealing with anxiety share how the Apostle Paul confronts the nature of worry and the possibility of a life of peace through his personal and poignant letter to the Philippians.

Paul offers some of the most transforming verses of the Bible in Philippians 4: 4-9. These often used verses are under-applied and misunderstood for how they work together to lead the readers out of the grasp of anxiety and worry to a life that transforms from the balm of "peace that passes understanding" to actually walking with the 'God of Peace'.

Rev. Stanford and Dr. Kent focus on verse 8 of chapter 4- what they refer to as 'The Anxiety Algorithm'. What does it mean to meditate on this seemingly simple but unlikely random list of images the Paul shares in verse 8- The authors suggest this is a spiritual algorithm for re-focusing the mind.
