

September 15 – Depart USA

Depart on our international overnight flight.

September 16 - Arrive in Lourdes

Arrive this afternoon at an airport near Lourdes where our representative will escort us to our hotel in Lourdes. Celebrate Mass.

September 17 – Lourdes

This morning we will celebrate Mass before our journey through the Pyrenees to Lourdes. We will enjoy a walking tour of the Sanctuary grounds and a visit to the homes of Bernadette and her family. It was here in Lourdes that Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous 18 times in 1858. It has become a place of pilgrimage for millions of the faithful each year, and the spring water from the grotto is believed to have healing properties. While in Lourdes, you will have opportunity to participate in the afternoon processional and the evening candlelight processional, as well as partake in the healing waters of Lourdes.

September 18 – Lourdes – Train to Paris

This morning we will have a morning departure from Lourdes with a train ride to Paris through the Loire Valley. After our guide and driver pick us up at the train station, we will enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, including seeing the Seine, the Champs Elysees, and the Arc de Triomphe. A highlight will be our visit to the Eiffel Tower. Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal on Rue de Bac. St. Catherine was visited by Mary three times in 1830 that encouraged a revival in devotion to the church. She served the poor of Paris for 46 years, and when her body was exhumed, it was found incorrupt. The Miraculous Medal is based on a design given by Mary to St. Catherine. We will then transfer to our hotel.

September 19 - Paris

This morning we will head to the lle de la Citie, home to Notre Dame. This 850-year-old Gothic Cathedral remains the center of the French and their faith. From here, we'll visit Saint Chapelle, the private chapel of kings, illuminated with streams of colored light through towering stained-glass windows. Then we will journey across the Seine to the Chapel of St. Vincent de Paul where we

will celebrate Mass. Then we'll head north through the city past the Place de la Concorde (once home to the guillotine in the French Revolution) to La Madeleine, containing a relic of Mary Magdalene. This picturesque church serves as a popular wedding venue. Then take a ride up the funicular to Montmartre and Sacre Coeur. This cathedral looks out over Paris from the place where St. Denis was martyred. While here, wander the art shops and stores that line the streets. Enjoy time this afternoon on your own to explore and shop.

September 20 – Rouen and Lisieux


Today we leave Paris to the south as we head to Rouen. Claude Monet made this cathedral internationally famous with his paintings in the late 19th century. Also here is the Church of Saint Maclou and the Tour Jeanne d'Arc, where Joan of Arc was threatened with torture in 1431. Celebrate Mass at one of the churches here. We'll continue to Lisieux and the Basilica of St. Therese, the second most visited pilgrimage site in France after Lourdes. St. Therese served her simple and spiritual life at the Carmelite Order here, and her writings have gone on to inspire millions.

September 21 - Normandy Beaches / Bayeux

This morning, celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Lisieux. We will then head for the beaches of Normandy, where on June 6, 1944, Allied forces began the invasion of Europe to liberate it from the grip of Nazi Germany. Visit the D-Day Museum and the cemeteries. Continue on to Bayeux. The Bayeux Tapestry, created for William the Conqueror to commemorate his victory at the Battle of Hastings in 1066, is on display here at a local museum. Notre Dame de Bayeux, built in 1077, was its original home.

September 22 - Mont St. Michel

This morning we'll journey to Mont St. Michel, an island consecrated in 708. It was one of the first places of cult for the Archangel Michel with the Gargan's Mount. The abbey presents a broad panorama of the medieval architecture from the 11th to the 16th century. We will celebrate Mass here on the island.



September 23 - Chartres and Paris

We will travel this morning to Chartres. The Cathedral of Notre Dame of Chartres contains a tunic that belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Sancta Camisia. This garment was a gift to the church by Charlemagne upon his return from the Holy Land. The Cathedral was begun in 1145 and became a popular pilgrimage site in the 12th century. Celebrate Mass here before we return to Paris for free time to explore and shop.

September 24 - Depart for USA

Return home heartened and enlightened by the people, places and history of our faith found in France.
