Martin Luther & the Reformation

June 19 - Depart USA

Depart on your international overnight flight.

June 20 - Arrive in Berlin - Transfer to Hotel

Arrive in Berlin, where your guide will greet and escort you to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 21 - Wittenberg - Castle Church / Church of St. Mary / Luther House / Melanchthon House

This morning, wander the town of Wittenberg, where Luther lived and taught for 36 years. See where he posted his 95 Theses on the Palace Church door, giving voice to the Reformation. Visit Schlosskirche, where Luther was buried, and explore Luther Halle, a former monastery where Martin lived with his family. You'll visit St. Mary's Church, where Luther often preached. Also walk through the home of Philip Melanchthon, a fellow professor and Reformer who worked with Luther. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 22 - Torgau - Schloss Hartenfels - Castle Chapel / St. Marian Church

Walk the streets of Torgau and visit St. Marian's Church, where Katharina von Bora, wife of Martin Luther is buried. Luther dedicated the chapel at Schloss Hartenfels castle here in 1544. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 23 - Leipzig - St. Nicholas Church / Auerbachs Keller (not included) / St Thomas Boys Choir

In Leipzig, you'll walk to St. Thomas Church where Luther preached and Bach served as cantor and choir director. It contains a large stained glass window depicting Luther with his translation of the Bible. Listen to a performance of the St. Thomas' Boys' Choir if they are in residence. See also the Neues Rathaus, the city hall built over the castle where Johann Eck and Martin Luther debated in 1519. You'll also see St. Nicholas' Church, protestant since 1539 and home of the meeting of dissident protest at the end of the communism in East Germany. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 24 - Dresden - Protestant Church of our Lady / Catholic Court Church / Zwinger Palace

There is a memorial to Martin Luther in front of the Frauenkirche. The reconstructed Protestant Church of Our Lady was completely destroyed during WWII, and has now been reopened. See also the Catholic Court Church – the Cathedral of the Dresden Diocese. Spend time in the Zwinger Palace, now a collection of museums. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.



June 25 - Halle and Eisleben - Halle (Market Church) / Eisleben - Church of St Peter and Paul / St Andrews / Birth House / Death House

Start the day in Halle, where Luther supported the Market Church constructed here. Later, George Handel would be baptized here in 1685. Cardinal Albert of Mainz precipitated the onset of the Reformation through his sale of indulgences and the Protestants in Halle bought him out of his position. Continue on to Eisleben, where Luther's life both began and ended. Luther was baptized at St. Petri (St. Peter & St. Paul's Church), where you can see portraits of his wife and parents. This charming little town includes the Luther Family Home, as well as the house Luther was visiting at the time of his death. Walk the medieval cobblestone streets past St. Andrew's Church, where Luther preached his last sermon. Check in for dinner and overnight in Erfurt.

June 26 - Wartburg Castle and Eisenach - Bach House / Luther House - Erfurt – Monastery

Martin Luther lived in Eisenach during his student days. Learn about Luther's life and the Reformation at the Luther House Museum, and tour the famous Wartburg Castle, where Luther translated the New Testament into German in 1522. View the room where Luther completed his translation in just 11 weeks. Also visit the birthplace of Johann Sebastian Bach. Return to Erfurt and visit the Augustinian Monastery where Martin Luther was a monk. See also St. Mary's Cathedral overlooking the town square. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 27 - Buchenwald & Weimar

Just 10 miles outside Weimar is the concentration camp of Buchenwald where Dietrich Bonhoeffer, German Lutheran pastor and theologian, was held prisoner along with hundreds of thousands. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 28 - Berlin - Kaiser Wilhelm Church Memorial / Brandenburg Gate / Reichstag / Checkpoint Charlie

A driving tour of Berlin will introduce you to such sites as the Brandenburg Gate and the rebuilt Reichstag, whose transparent dome represents the open government of the nation. Pass the ruins of the Kaiser Wilhelm Gedachtniskirche, left as a poignant reminder of what was lost in the Second World War and stop at a section of the Berlin Wall, a stark testimony to the once divided city. Take a photo at Checkpoint Charlie, the infamous crossing point from East to West Berlin during the Cold War Era. Check into your Berlin hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 29 - Museum Island – German History Museum: The Luther Effect - Afternoon - Sansoucci Palace and grounds

This morning, you'll visit Museum Island and the German History Museum to explore the Luther Effect. The exhibit illustrates the global diversity and effective history of Protestantism. This afternoon, you'll walk the grounds of Sansoucci Palace and Gardens, once home to Frederick the Great. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

CANCELLATION FEES:
